Student: The Ace of Wands and the 2 of Wands popped out while shuffling and asking the question. I feel that perhaps I rely on the inspiration of my intuition more than just it being a part of me with the Ace of Wands. As for the 2 of Wands, I think I am discovering a way to take action of this inspiration, which I think is through the Tarot itself as it gives me a visual to make the connections with.

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

Student: 1) Ace of Swords: if it begins with a thought, then this is The card for me. the essential thought.

2) King of Cups: as he has mastered his emotions so that he can infuse it the thought with enough emotion and love to give it life without weighing it down with too much water/emotion.

3) Knight of Pentacles: he is hard working and can take the emotion infused thought and work towards the goal to success.

Mentor: Great choice of the elements Chaitali, The Ace of Swords is an excellent card to start with and the King of Cups energy will be wonderfully controlled. The Knight of Pentacles will not give up no matter what.

Transfer your understanding of your choice of cards and think of a situation that can be represented by the energy of the cards you chose.

Student: "The situation could be how best to deal with a work problem where a solution is needed, but none has been provided yet.

With the Ace the of Swords you have the initial Aha moment which provides a new way to deal with the problem; perhaps a new method of approaching the situation. With the King of Cups, I feel that he offers an emotionally balanced viewpoint so that he would be able to give the new solution a try without being held back by the saying 'we have always done it this way, so this is how we will do it.'" I feel that the King of Cups would represent the main boss. With the Knight of Pentacles I feel he can take the new thought and with the clear instructions of the King of Cups, materialize a new approach in which everyone wins. He is able to physically make the new plan happen by directing himself and his army (his co-workers). "

Mentor:Very interesting thoughts on this, I can see how you have associated the Hermit in each scenario and it certainly does resonate.


What was it about the image that initiated your feelings and understanding on it's energy?

Mentor: I can see how you may feel this way, do you think that the purple offers any additional insight? If not, that's absolutely fine because this is about how you feel about the images.



Mentor:

Give your thoughts on the reading but it only needs to be brief.

Student: Yes I will as now I am looking to the future with the energy of the Q of Wands after reviewing my past as the K of wands, helping me understand that I was trying to balance too many opportunities giving nothing my full attention in turn finding myself upside down and unbalanced and unenergized.

Mentor: Chaitali, I think the reading will benefit from looking at from the very beginning again. You are spot on with your general feel of the reading in regards to you finding yourself unable to give focus...This especially shows in the reading. I am going to list each card and add notes next to it.

1 **Past:** 2 of Pentacles Rx: The energy of the 2 of Pentacles in its reversed position shows how difficult you found balancing the dynamics of your life. This is past tense, it may help you to list some of the issues that you were experiencing. The presence of the 2 of Pentacles also tells us that you could have managed but something was blocking it. You can note this also.

Chaitali: The 2 of Pentacles Rx to me felt like I was juggling way too many things at the time, which turned me upside down and flat. The past was filled with a wedding planning business, a part time metaphysics shop manager and budding intuitive,

hair/makeup/henna artist, full time mom + dad role at times as my husband was primarily on the road of two young and close in age (17 months apart) children, and all the while trying to keep up the house and the social side of life. I tried to be SuperMom/Business woman with very little support. . . .which I feel was the block, I didn't accept the help that may have been there because I didn't feel i deserved, which is probably the Main block. . . my self worth of the Pentacles.

2. **Present:** King of Wands. The King of Wands is an amazing business man, he is dynamic and knows what he wants. He is a positive in any reading for business but as with all readings, we need to consider the other cards. I would question why we have the 9 of Cups at the outcome and the Queen as an issue.

Chaitali: With the King of Wands, I feel that he is reviewing the past, all of the above stated in purple and weighing it out. I feel the K is putting structure together and helping me decide on 1 main focus for business and helping me put the support structures in place for my family, especially my children. I also feel that the K represents an element of my husband as a business man, reminding me to lean on his expertise and realize that he is my ally and partner. But please understand that I do not feel that is the main focus of this King. . . .just a side note as I feel it is up to me to develop the structure and which business. I feel the Q as the dynamic affecting it is me accepting the help and advice at face value and not taking it personally. My husband and I have gone a few rounds in the past when it comes to a profession for me as his work takes a lot of his time, so his belief for my profession is the Domestic Diva, where the children are the top priority. I am now in a place to accept this as my main "job," but need something that also stimulates my mind and gives me something of my own. . .hope that makes sense.

3: **Dynamics affecting the issue:** Queen of Wands: It is important that we look at why the Queen of Wands is an issue and affecting your business opportunity. The Queen is normally wonderful for a business, she manages the family, the school runs and the business BUT we may be seeing that there is an issue of you managing this. You are making the right decision s (King) but you also need to be able to fulfil your other aspects of life. I would look at the aspects of your life and then make notes with regards.

Chaitali: As stated in the King of Wands, I feel that this Q may be an issue based on my accepting the King, in this case I think this is where the K may represent my husband. I need to accept that I do have a primary role of caretaker, which I feel i have finally accepted without feeling that this is not enough of a role. I see now that this is a

blessing and not a burden to be here for my children at all times as it will help them develop and grow, especially given my husband's career is quite time consuming and has us moving around the world. I think that with the acceptance of this fact, I am better able to balance my priorities with my wants and allocate the correct amount of time and energy.

4. **Advice:** Chariot: I love the Chariot for advice because the card gives us great insight to our issues and the energy around us. The Chariot shows the Charioteer, driving forward his vehicle with two energies pulling in different directions. What is it that you find to be pulling you in different directions? The Chariot suggests that you follow the path that is best for you spiritually and those in your life. You can achieve all that you want but it will take determination.

Chaitali: I love the Chariot too! It makes me feel in control but with a keen sense of how to use this control so that it is fair to all, myself and my family! I feel that I am learning to balance my wants and needs so that it is not selfish, as it may have been in the past. Again, with the acceptance of my main role, I feel that I can now add additional roles such as a career role and not have it cause issues in my family structure. Understanding that I can have a “hobby” that I am paid for is a bonus and that I do not need to be the main breadwinner to be worthy! I am fulfilling a main role that is beneficial to my family, though I may not be paid for it and it is okay.

5. **Best outcome:** 9 of Cups: The 9 of Cups, it is often seen as a wish card although not for my reads. I would ask yourself if you are missing something in your life and the business will (hope) fulfill this?

Chaitali: The 9 of Cups is a card that represents me putting my affairs in order and prioritizing most important to least important, starting with my family as #1 all the way down to the laundry. I feel the business would add to my sense of purpose and worth, even though I now understand that I am worthy. . . . being paid isn't the only form of currency that makes me valuable. The business will also satisfy my need to help others. . . a purpose that have always been a driving value and goal for me since childhood.

Shadow +2: 5 of Swords, Rx



Mentor: Yes, you NEED to consider your own outlet, you are you and are to be valued as much as you value and care for others. How you feel and think is important,.





They can be calm and steadfast as to their approach, like the woman in the picture. She is coddling the Lion and taking charge of it with kindness and love. The statement "kill them with kindness" comes to mind. I feel that if the advice is taken and a softer, more gentle approach is taken, then the sitter will be successful at balancing the give and take of the relationship and both parties will enjoy the relationship dynamic much more! There will be a reason to celebrate at the end. . . .

Mentor: How beautiful it sounds Chaitali. The connection speaks to you in a wonderfully deep level.

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

Take a look at the spread and when you are ready, clear your mind (meditate on the image above if you would like) and prepare for a reading. Ask the High Priestess to guide you through your reading.

Student:What is the outcome of my Tarot development?

Jumper: 8 of Pentacles

Card 1: The Magician

Card 2: 4 of Wands

Card 3: 4 of Cups, Rx

Card 4: Queen of Swords, Rx

Card 5: 4 of Pentacles, Rx

Card 6: The Star, Rx

Firstly, the jumper of 8 of Pentacles to me feels that I will continue learning the trade under mentorship especially since this is the "Apprentice Card". . .which makes sense as I am enrolled in the Certificate Program. Also I noticed all of the reversals and the 4's of stability. With the Past of The Magician, I feel that I was given the tools with which to grow and enhance the "magic" that I was already gifted with by Spirit, but did I use my will to create and grow that gift. Moving to the present of the 4 of Wands, I feel that I have stabilized my family life so that I may also now add the Tarot as a career and life will still be harmonious and stable as I will know my boundaries. With the expected outcome of 4 of Cups Reversed, I feel that the time is now to continue to grow my skillset and to perhaps branch out and start offering readings. Don't keep the gifts in the cups, perhaps it is time to release them. I feel with the Queen of Swords Reversed as the energy that brings the 4 of Cups, Rx that the Queen is guiding the 4th cup. If we look at both cards, it seems like it is her hand that gifts me the ace of cups. . . .meaning to me that I have the mental ability to do this, but at times lose my confidence and feel upside down about my development. Sometimes I feel that I do not really know what I am doing and do not put myself out there because I am afraid to fail. Though with the Queen's softer nature (given her reversed position) influencing me I should have the confidence to continue and to branch out, and with her softer nature learn how to deliver the messages with more warmth and compassion than this Queen is normally known for all the while still delivering a direct message. The guidance to bring the new outcome of the Star Reversed is to not be stingy with my knowledge and skill set. If I keep it to myself, then I do not grow the same and can not help others due to my stifled position and lack of growth. The Star Reversed to me feels like my hopes will be delivered, like bringing the energy of the Star to the ground in practical applications. In other words, it is time to stop just wishing about it but to start doing it in everyday life.

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I am pleased to see that you looked over the reading and pulled out aspects that stood out to you.
